

## Elizabeth Cabell Dugdale Award for Conservation

### Guidelines

1. Nominations must be made in writing and submitted by June 1 to the Chairman of the GCV Conservation Awards Committee.
2. Nominations may be submitted by GCV members or member clubs only.
3. Eligibility is limited to organizations, industries or an individual who is NOT a GCV member.
4. The recipient must, in the judgment of the Conservation Awards Committee of the GCV, have rendered outstanding service in the conservation and wise development of the natural resources of the Commonwealth of Virginia.
5. The medal will be presented at the GCV Conservation Forum each year.

The following information should be included in the nomination proposal:

1. Name of Proposing Club or GCV Member
2. Address, phone, and email
3. Name of Nominee
4. Biographical sketch of the individual or short history of the organization or industry proposed.
5. Proposal which gives specific examples of how the nominee has rendered outstanding service in the conservation and wise development of our natural resources. This is limited to 400 words.

Supporting materials are encouraged. These items may include photos, copies of newspaper, magazine or journal articles concerning the nominee's contributions to conservation.

Nominations may be submitted by mail or email.
